- Are there religious beliefs or myths dominating your society?
- What are your hopes for the future?
- How long do most people live in the time you've chosen?
- What is the most common cause of death?
- Who are some of the now-famous people in the world at the time you have chosen?
- Would you have known about them? Why or why not?
